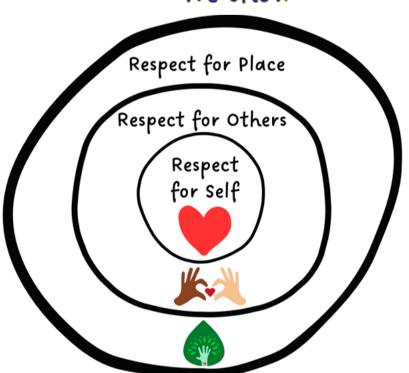
# Our goal was to include...
