

Graceville station accessibility upgrade

Night works – September/October 2016

As part of the Graceville station accessibility upgrade, platform upgrade work will occur on selected nights during September and October 2016.

For the safety of workers and customers, and in order to maintain rail services, these works must be undertaken at night. Wherever possible, noisy works will be scheduled before 10pm.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption and we apologise for any inconvenience.

Traffic management controls will be in place on Honour Avenue and Appel Street, adjacent to the station precinct, to allow for the delivery of machinery and materials. Pedestrians and motorists are advised to follow all signage and traffic management controls during this time.
