

Graceville station accessibility upgrade

Night works – December 2016

As part of the Graceville station accessibility upgrade, night work will continue at the station on **selected dates in December**.

For the safety of customers and project workers, this work has been scheduled after hours, when there is reduced activity on the line.

Activities include work to lifts, awning refurbishment and civil works on all platforms, pedestrian ramps (from Honour Avenue and Appel Street), and drainage and lift works in the subway. Crane lifts will be used from Honour Avenue and Appel Street to access the platforms.

Residents and businesses adjacent to Graceville station may experience some noise from truck movements and construction activity.

Traffic management controls will be in place on Honour Avenue and Appel Street, adjacent to the station precinct, to allow for the delivery of machinery and materials. Pedestrians and motorists are advised to follow all signage and traffic management controls during this time.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption. Queensland Rail apologises for any inconvenience and appreciates the local community's cooperation during these important works.
