Spellathon test day will be **TUESDAY 19 MARCH.** The spelling list for your child is attached. The sponsorship form is included for students to begin seeking sponsorship or donations from family, friends and neighbours (giving due consideration to your child's safety).

Sponsorship forms need to be returned to school on TUEDSDAY 19 MARCH so that the class teacher can enter the total words your child completed correctly. This form will then be sent home again with your child so you can include the sponsorship money. Please do not send any money on 19 March.

Sponsorship forms and money are due back to the office by TUESDAY 2 APRIL for your child to be eligible to win prizes. To minimise the possibility of cash being misplaced we offer payment via School24, credit card or cheque.

School24 is the online ordering system used for tuckshop and fete purchases, and is offered as an easy and safe option for Spellathon donations from 20/3 until 7/4. If you don't have a School24 account yet, go to school24.net.au to register and follow the prompts. Use Graceville School ID code 25314963.

PRIZE LIST

There will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize awarded for each year level as well as an opportunity for every child who spells all their words correctly to be entered in a prize draw where they could win one of two fun prizes in each year level.

1st prize	Value \$100	\$40 Bim Bam Boom gift voucher \$40 Australian Geographic gift voucher \$20 Smiggle gift voucher
2nd prize	Value \$75	\$30 Bim Bam Boom gift voucher \$25 Australian Geographic gift voucher \$20 Smiggle voucher
3rd prize	Value \$50	\$30 Australian Geographic gift voucher \$20 Smiggle gift voucher

The main prizes will be awarded to students based on a combination of correctly spelt words and the amount of sponsorship raised. Prizes will be awarded to the children on a points basis i.e. 1 point per word correctly identified and 1 point per \$ raised.

Example: 20 correct words identified = 20 points \$10 raised = 10 points Total = 30 points

The students who accumulate the maximum points by this combined method will be awarded prizes at an assembly early in Term 2. The exciting prize draw for students who spell all their words correctly will also be done at this assembly.

Please encourage your children to be involved and support their efforts. No matter how small the amount of sponsorship, your child should feel proud that they have contributed.
